

Randolph Pattinson Charity

By a will dated 31st March 1691, Randolph Pattinson left to the 'Poor of Beckingham and Sutton' the income from the Poor Gardens.

The 'Poor Gardens' consists of just over 2 acres, and is located on the immediate left after the houses when leaving the village on Sleaford Road.

It is currently let on an annual tenancy with the proceeds available for distribution.

There should be four trustees for the charity, but the term for two of these has now expired, and this notice is asking for anyone interested in becoming a trustee to notify the Parish Clerk, Mrs Judith Lyon. A decision will be taken by the Parish Council at their next meeting, scheduled for the 16th of June
