Cllr Mary Green reported:

- 1. EMAS & the update of defibrillators within NKDC. I have contacted all my ward villages re defibrillators and have sent the correct/updated information to a NK officer collating this for onward Submission to EMAS.
 - Although many villages believed they were up to date it transpired that there were errors in early every village that holds a defibrillator. These ranged from not being shown on the EMAS map or wrong numbers of defibrillators held by a village or wrong location or correct address but wrong postcode or a combination. Hopefully, within a short space of time everything with EMAS will be back on track.
 - 2. NKDC Tree Strategy is out for consultation with a closing date of 4th December 2020. If there are any Parish Councils that are considering starting community woodlands on Parish owned lands no matter how small, please comment on the strategy, your views are much appreciated.
 - 3. The Police & Crime Commissioner for Lincolnshire Marc Jones, has recently launched his annual survey inviting residents to have their say on how their communities are policed. To make comments visit bit.ly/PCCSurvey9, again this has a direct Impact on local communities and villages so let him know your thoughts!
 - 4. Business Grants Local Restriction Grant Scheme for businesses required to close during the current lockdown. Applications close on Friday 4th December 2020. This time the scheme includes businesses that don't pay business rates such as Mobile Hairdressers/Taxi Drivers etc, if you are aware of any residents in your villages that this may be of help to Let them know details can be found on the NKDC website.
